102-Metre trimaran superyacht design

Australian yacht designer Misha Merzliakov has unveiled a 102m superyacht design based on shipbuilder Austal's unique trimaran hullform. The trimaran hullform is a proven platform which offers superior seakeeping, greater speed and fuel economy. The advantages of Austal's innovative trimaran platform have been proven in commercial operation since 2005, and this leading technology is now available for the superyacht industry.
