European accents have been introduced into the all-new Whitehaven Euro Edition 6100.

estined to command attention in Darling Harbour at its launch in August 2018, the Whitehaven Euro Edition 6100 will be the first of the new-era models born from the collaboration between Whitehaven and naval architect and yacht designer Misha Merzliakov.

"Whitehaven owners are well travelled, experienced boat owners who have accumulated a list of 'must haves'," said Merzliakov. "They are confident in their choices, they have the world at their fingertips and they know what they want in terms of allocation of spaces, styling and features."

With the exterior of the 6100, Merzliakov has introduced a range of automotive cues to imbue the vessel with a sleek profile reflective of its performance.

Fitted with two newgeneration 1,200hp Caterpillar C12.9 engines, the yacht expected to cruise comfortably at 25 knots, and have a top speed of 30 knots.

As beautiful as it is practical, a full-length roofline over the aft cockpit provides protection for all climates and conditions, as well as adding to its streamlined aesthetic.

The generously proportioned entertainers' cockpit flows through to an aft galley with a spacious dining area featuring a six-seater freestanding dining table.

"There are a few innovative surprises in the saloon, too, so stay tuned for further details prior to release," added the Australia-based designer.

Inside, the amenities are controlled by the innovative

C-Zone boat management system, a control panel which can be operated remotely through a handheld device.

Interiors feature "tried and tested materials used in a novel way", incorporating European accents and attributes which have traditionally been reserved for superyachts.

"With the clever use of geometry and configuration, we have found additional space for storage, seating and room to spread out. The accommodation was inspired by motor yachts double its size," said Merzliakov.

The Euro Edition 6100 offers a three-bedroom, two-bathroom layout with an additional auxiliary room/ butler's pantry or day head. Whitehaven also offers the Euro model as a 6300 variant, with a spacious second rear full-beam stateroom or beach club alternative, which opens fully to the transom swimming platform. Both of these options see the tender move from the fully enclosed garage onto the hydraulically operated swimming platform.

A range of layout, feature and colour palette variations are available, and clients are encouraged to tailor the vessel to their lifestyle needs.

True to Whitehaven's ethos of crafting entirely bespoke luxury motor yachts, the Euro Edition 6100 embodies Whitehaven's superior bluewater capability and performance. Like every Whitehaven, the Euro Edition 6100 comes with a five-year structural warranty and three-year general warranty. whitehavenmotoryachts.com.au
